SNC request comments on the **private road to The Priory** to be named Mill Lane:

As Mill Lane already exists from Bridge Road and is gated at the private road point, with an unnamed link access from Bridge Road between Mill Lane and the Village Hall entrance, it may be more prudent to name the private road as Priory Lane rather than Mill Lane > **for approval**

Parking issues outside 42 Bridge Road do not breach planning conditions says SNC enforcement but is highways/police matter (confirmed by inspection of Planning Permission, although issue raised at planning stage) > **noted**
